

#### **TEMPUS FUGIT HISTORY VISIT**

On Thursday 21st October, KS2 had a visit from Tempus Fugit who are a theatre and education company providing living history/historical costumed shows around the country.

#### **Rock Up with the Early Britons**

Years 3, 4 and 5 had a surprise visit from world-renowned archaeologist Dr Indiana Bones, who took them on a tour from the Palaeolithic to the Iron Age. The children dressed in outfits from each area and saw how textile technology developed through time, as well as examining tools and the diet of prehistoric humans. There was a song from every time period, which really helped us understand the key features of life in the Stone, Bronze and Iron Ages. It was particularly interesting to learn about religion in Iron Age Britain, and how the druids and rulers like Boudicca clashed with Roman invaders.

#### **Roman Life**

Years 4, 5 and 6 were then transported to the Roman town of Castrum Deva Victrix (Chester) to meet the Roman blacksmith Maximus Decimus Meridius. He offered the children his wares, including centurions, legionaries and auxiliary soldiers' unforms, jewellery and belts, and shields. He even gave us a demonstration of different Roman shield techniques. Finally, he explained about the different shops around his in the forum, and how every shop-owner prayed to a different God. Maximus explained that his votive of Mars, the god of war, was very precious to him!



#### **SHOW RACISM THE RED CARD**

On **Thursday 21st October**, the children and staff wore red to raise awareness about racism within society.

We thought about how Jesus taught us to love everybody regardless of colour or race. We talked about how some people are treated differently because of their skin tone, and everyone agreed this was unkind and unfair.
